DATE: Saturday October 15th. rain or shine.

TIME: 12:00pm - 4:00pm

LOCATION: Central Park of Morris County, Central Ave, (former Greystone),

Parsippany, NJ

THEME: Dog Howl'oween costume party.

PURPOSE: Fundraising for Fighting Children's Cancer Foundation. A not-for-profit

organization assisting families with pediatric cancer children for 25 years.

PARTNERS: Morris County K-9 – The Seeing Eye – Mt Pleasant Animal Shelter

ACTIVITIES: A. Doggie trick or treat.

The area shall have sponsored tents/tables approx. 20 feet apart. The participants, with their dog, will walk from one sponsored tent to another to receive a treat given by the sponsor.

- B. Sponsored prop fire hydrants, called "canine wetsites" spread around the site to "accommodate" the dogs.
- C. Doggie obstacle course.
- D. Morris County K-9 team information booth and demonstration.
- E. Seeing Eye Information booth and demonstration.
- F. Mt. Pleasant Animal Shelter information and pet adoption center.
- G. Food trucks.

H. Dogs on parade.

The main event of the afternoon shall be a costumed dog show. The event shall be divided in 3 categories: small medium and large dogs. The participating dogs shall be paraded in front of a jury of cancer fighting FCCF children, with an election of "top dog" trophy winners.

- I. Howl'oween program: Event program shall include names/breed of the dog and name of owner- ads from sponsors
- J. Tricky tray.
- L. Life Music band.
- M. Event Program with name of pre-registered dogs and sponsors adds.
- N. All participants will receive a "goodie bag" with promotional materials and items.

- E. 2 food trucks in the parking area.
